

UKI US Open 2024 Sunday Notes

Ring 1 is in the Main arena. Rings 4, 5 & 6 are in the Covered arena.

Please refer to the US Open 2024 Site plan.

Course maps will be available on the UKI web page, US Open UKI Facebook page, on the GAC App and on Agility Gate at the stated publish time.

During Course walking, a space will be created between the ring barriers so you can easily move from one ring to the next.

Height rotation is small to tall. (Once numbers progressing is known for the Challenger, we will announce which height is in which ring, please check which height is in which ring).

The Challenger is split over 4 rings, the Challenger course walking is a 20-minute course walk open to all in all 4 rings. Your 20 minutes needs to be divided between the rings you are running in. These courses will be as close to identical as the course builders can make them.

If you have 2 dogs in different heights, you need to check which height is in which ring. You will need to walk all courses if you have dogs in multiple rings. These courses will be as close to identical as the course builders can make them.

For handlers with multiple dogs **in different heights** in the Challenger, you may have conflicts between rings. It is your responsibility to liaise with the Ring Manager in the ring you will run your 2nd dog, to confirm you will be late before your run is due to happen. **The ring manager will let you know when you need to run.**

If your dogs are drawn close together in the **same ring** and there are not enough dogs in the height to create the required space, you will have CON next to your name on the published PDF running orders (not Agility Gate version). The ring manager therefore knows to give you the allotted time between runs.

Competition times are estimations only and these may start **EARLIER** than scheduled. The start time of the Team Final and National Final will not be known until Sunday due to the unknown numbers progressing to The Challenger. The Team Final will not start before 09.00 and will also not start until all Challenger rounds finish. If this is after 09.00, the Team Final Course Walking will commence shortly after the last Challenger dog runs.

The National Final Course Walking will commence as soon as the course is built.

Please pay close attention to all official event announcements for start times. These will be displayed on the White boards and screens at the ring. We will also post on the message service in the GAC App and on the US Open UKI Facebook page. The white boards/screens at the rings are your definitive source of information.

Please volunteer to help when you are not running.

It is your responsibility to be at the ring on time and to be aware of the start times.
